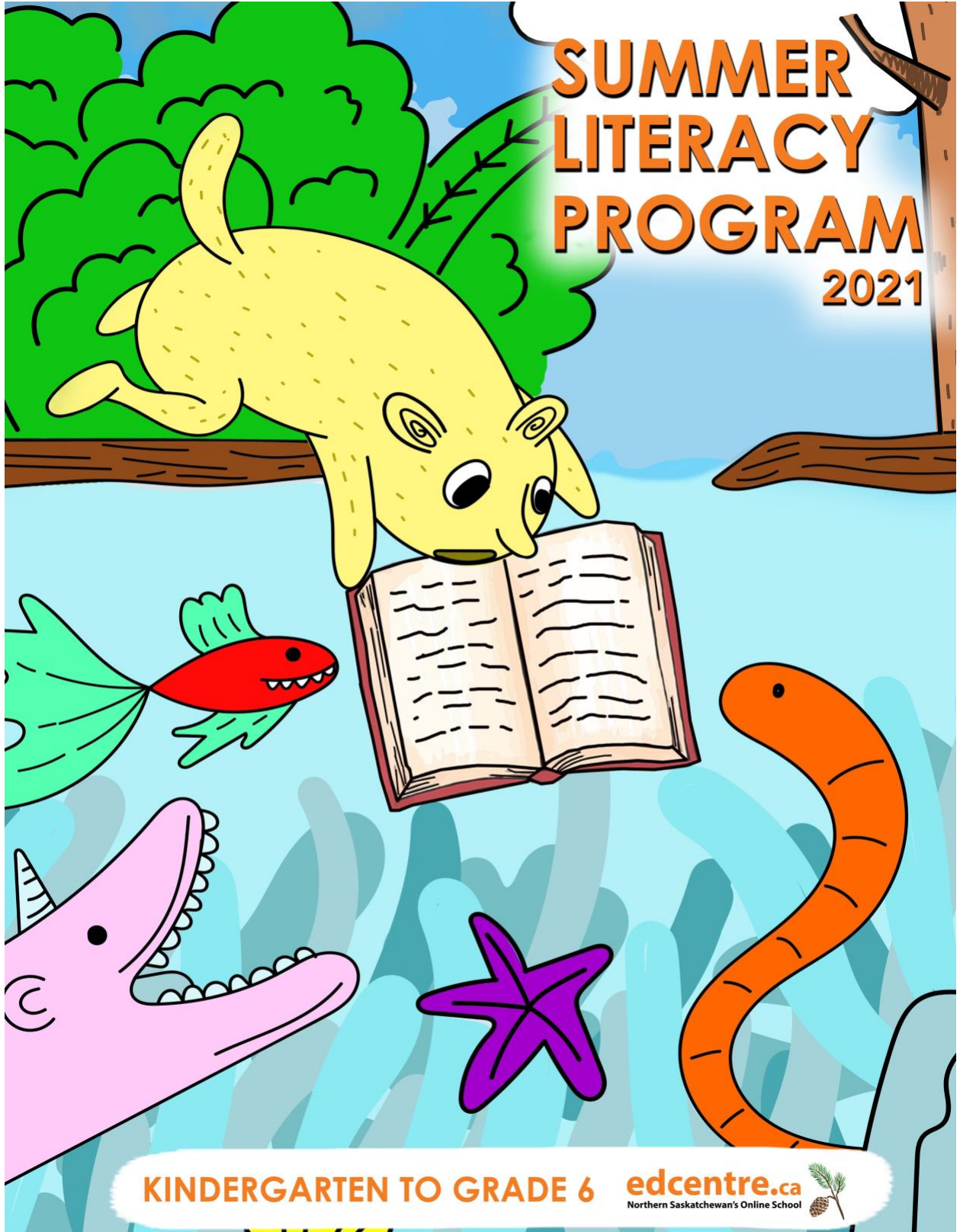


SUMMER LITERACY PROGRAM 2021

What?

Are you looking for summer programming to help build your child’s literacy skills? The edcentre.ca Online school is running an online summer literacy program for students in Kindergarten to Grade 6. The edcentre summer literacy program is a great way for students to enrich their literacy skills while engaging in fun online activities in grade a like groupings. Attendance to all sessions is not mandatory, so even if you aren’t able to attend all sessions, you can still enjoy the program!

When?

The online literacy program will run through Microsoft Teams from July 5th – July 30th. Students will be able to connect with their teacher according to the following schedule:

The summer literacy program is a free program for any student that is in Kindergarten – Grade 6 and living in the Northern Administrative District.

Do I have to register?

We encourage everyone that is interested to register for this program. For students that are registered in the program by June 21st, 2021 the edcentre will send out a container of materials for you to use in this program. If you do not register prior to June 21st you are still welcome to attend the sessions. Most of the content in the lessons can be done without all the material that is sent out to students; however, if possible early registration will help ensure that the materials used in this program make their way to your home.

What do I need to participate?

To participate in the online literacy program you will need a computer or tablet, and an internet connection. Headphones are recommended as they will help the students better hear the teacher. Craft supplies will be provided to students that register prior to June 21st, 2021.
