



What is the Moodle app?

The moodle app is a free application available through Google Play or the Apple store on your phone. It was designed by Moodle to provide students with access to their course content and class activities while on the move. [Video](#) (version 3.1)

Moodle App Advantages

- Access course content anywhere without a laptop.
- Get instant notifications of messages or other events
- Easily submit assignments in picture, video, audio, and scanned document form.
- Easily message your teacher or other students in your class
- Complete quizzes, respond to discussion forums, and type responses in assignments that have text submission boxes.
- Quickly check grades

How to connect the app to your courses.

1. Download the app onto your phone
2. Use your browser to navigate to the log-in page for your courses
3. Copy the address for your log-in page
4. Open the moodle app
5. Paste the address for your log-in page OR
Manually enter the URL (address) of your moodle log-in page

6. Enter your username and password

How to change users (useful for parents/mentors if there is more than one student in the family)

1. Go to the hamburger link (bottom right of the page)
2. Click the Change Site option (Bottom of the list)
3. Click the plus sign (lower right)
4. Enter the address of the moodle log-in page
